GROUP COVENANT

1. CONFIDENTIALITY AND GRACE

This Beyond the Battle group is a safe place and is a place of grace. Each of us has been transformed by Jesus' grace, taken from death to life, so when someone shares sin or temptation struggles, we respond with the same grace that we have been shown by Jesus himself. Grace kills shame and this will be a group of grace, not shame. Each group member commits to showing this grace to one another and to keeping everything shared in this group 100% confidential.

2. ATTENDANCE

Each group member commits to being at all 7 of the group sessions. If someone can't make it to a session, they should wait to join a future Beyond the Battle group that they can attend all 7 sessions for. Each week will teach essential lessons to this journey of freedom, with each building upon the previous. Even more important than this is the high trust level that is required to be in this group. When someone shares something vulnerable, it's essential that no group members miss it. If they do, when they come back, they will not be at the same level of bonding and trust as the rest of the group and with the person who shared.

3. COVENANT EYES

Each group member commits to trying Covenant Eyes for free for 30 days. Use promo code BEYOND to receive your free 30 days. Covenant Eyes is a screen accountability software that takes screenshots of your online activity and emails them to the allies of your choice. The screenshots that get emailed are blurred out so as to not tempt the ally and to keep all sensitive information secure. Covenant Eyes is not the be-all-end-all solution to your sexual sin struggles, but it is an essential tool that supplements the Beyond the Battle group experience. For many men, this tool is a game changer. Even if you don't think that will be the case for you, the 30-day trial is still required so as to make everyone in the group comfortable and to give everyone the chance to experience this potential skyrocket in freedom. Install Covenant Eyes on all of your computers and mobile devices using the same username. Download Covenant Eyes from your app store and/or from www.covenanteyes.com.

4. ACCOUNTABILITY CARD

Each group member commits to fill out an Accountability Card each week, downloadable from the video website. In groups with a *leader*, all cards will be turned in to the leader each week. In groups not utilizing a leader role, men should be divided into *Peer Advocate* groups of 3 (or 4, if not divisible by 3) and Accountability Cards will be shared among the Peer Advocates in that triad. Cards can be submitted manually or electronically. The leader or Peer Advocates will check in midweek based on the info submitted on the card. Your first Accountability Card will be turned in 7 days after your group starts meeting.
